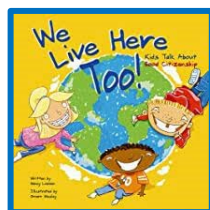

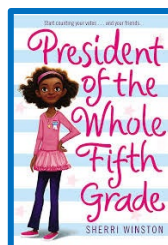

I Can Be a Good Digital Citizen by...

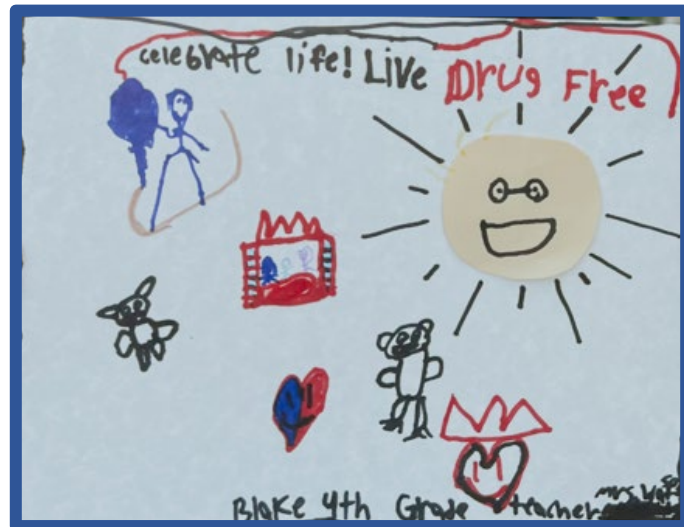
- Speaking to my teachers and classmates with respect and kindness
